A 1-5 page writing sample (Sample blog post you have written, a creative essay, etc.)

Funds will be released upon proof of acceptance into your program of study.

At BCSA we encourage creativity. In addition to the required documents you are welcome to send additional material in support of your application such as photographs, past blog entries, videos, etc.

The application deadline is **Monday, March 2, 2020**. Please write "Stories from Abroad: British Columbia Study Abroad Scholarship" in the subject line and submit your application in one PDF (including this checklist) to <u>info@bcstudyabroad.ca</u>.
